SCHOOL

We will try to do our utmost to-

- Follow actions as outlined in Attigo's Schools' Risk Assessment for the wider opening of school during COVID-19 Pandemic
- Provide increased supplies of antibacterial wash
- Increase the cleaning regime to minimise the risk of surface spread infection
- Rearrange resources and furniture to facilitate cleaning
- Provide a curriculum that prioritises children's welfare, physical exercise and promotes outdoor learning
- Continue to support families by responding to emails, sharing relevant information and signposting to support services
- Continue to ensure that safeguarding is always a priority
- Contact you if we are concerned about their child's health
- Inform you if anyone in your child's class tests positive for COVID-19
- Provide as much as possible, individual resources for each child so that they will not need to share
- Ensure adults, wherever possible, maintain a 1 metre + distance from each other and children

- Follow good hygiene rules: coughing and sneezing into my elbow or tissue (catch it– bin it– kill it)

PARENTS/CARERS

I/We will do our utmost to:-

- Ensure that we keep our child at home if showing possible symptoms of COVID-19 or they are unwell
- Make immediate arrangements to collect my/our child as soon as possible if contacted by the school to say that he/she is unwell
- **Book a test immediately if anyone in the family/household present with possible COVID symptoms and inform the school as soon as possible of the test date and outcome**
- Understand that if anyone in my/our child's class has tested positive for COVID, the class may be asked to stay at home and self-isolate for 14 days
- Follow social distancing measures by:
 - Following the latest government guidance on mixing with other households
 - Following school systems (as directed) for drop-offs and collection
 - Making every effort to arrive on time for drop-off and collection to avoid mixing with other year groups
 - Ensure only one adult at a time from my/our household can drop off and collect my/our child
- Only enter the school building with a pre-arranged appointment
- Communicate by email and telephone and only enter the Reception office area by appointment only (or in an emergency)
- Ensure the school has the most up-to-date emergency contact details
- Send my/our child to school in clean uniform
- Reinforce hygiene rules at home
- Ensure that children do not bring any items into school with them from home, with the exception of their PE kit, packed lunch (if applicable), break time snack and named water bottle
